HIV and Aids facilitation workshop

Client

Western Cape Education Department (Ikhaya Primary School)

Objectives

This one-day workshop has been designed to provide a forum where HIV/Aids and sexually-transmitted-infection issues can be openly discussed with learners. It should also assist them in making behaviour changes that reduce their risk of acquiring or transmitting HIV.

Tactics employed

- ◆ Covering principles of learners playing agent roles for positive change and the spreading of information in their society, thus sharing knowledge and skills gained

Outcomes

At the end of each workshop, learners

- ◆ had a better insight into HIV/Aids transmission and prevention,
- ◆ were empowered on positive youth participation in communities,
- ◆ were more confident in maintaining open and good communication channels (starting from their families) and making good choices on a daily basis.
